Fabarm has long been known for blending Italian craftsmanship with modern engineering, and the Fabarm Autumn shotgun is a clear reflection of that philosophy. Designed as a refined yet practical side-by-side for the field, the Autumn balances traditional aesthetics with proven Fabarm technology, making it an appealing option for upland hunters and sporting enthusiasts who value form, function and commitment to tradition.

At first glance, the Autumn presents itself as a classic game gun. Its clean lines, tasteful engraving, and well-proportioned walnut stock is offered with either an English or pistol grip,

catering to shooters of either persuasion. Unlike highly embellished presentation pieces, the Autumn maintains a distinguished look with beautiful case coloring on the receiver and elegant scroll engraving. The aesthetics on this model put it equally at home behind a pair of fine pointing dogs in the north woods or at the most prestigious side-by-side shoot in the country.

transitions through multiple bore dimensions, designed to reduce felt recoil, improve pattern consistency, and optimize velocity across a wide range of loads. In practical terms, this means the Autumn handles light upland loads with ease while remaining capable of digesting heavier shells when needed.

The shotgun comes standard with Fabarm's Inner HP choke system, allowing shooters to fine-tune patterns for different game and shooting conditions. Whether hunting tight-cover grouse, late-season pheasants, or even using the Autumn for occasional sporting clays, the choke versatility adds meaningful flexibility without complicating the gun's overall mission as a field-first design.

Under the surface, however, the Autumn benefits from the same engineering principles that have made Fabarm a respected name in competition and hunting circles worldwide. Central to the gun's performance are Fabarm's Tribore™ barrels, a hallmark of the brand. These barrels use a carefully engineered internal profile that gently

being whippy. This is especially important for snap shooting in dense cover, where fast target acquisition and follow-through matter more than raw weight or barrel length alone. The Autumn's relatively light profile reduces fatigue over long hunts while still offering enough mass to maintain control through the shot.

Handling is where the Autumn truly distinguishes itself. The balance point sits naturally between the hands, promoting a smooth, instinctive swing that feels lively without

The stock geometry is well thought out, offering a comfortable and natural mount for a wide range of shooters. Fabarm's attention to ergonomics is evident in the way the gun comes to the shoulder and aligns the shooter's eye along the solid rib without conscious adjustment. The trigger is crisp and predictable, aiding consistent shooting whether taking a quick flushing shot or a longer crossing bird.

Durability is another excellent attribute. Fabarm's actions are known for their strength and longevity, and the Autumn is no exception. Built to withstand real-world hunting conditions, the gun feels solid without being overbuilt. It inspires confidence that it will continue performing reliably season after season and for generations to come, even when exposed to the rigors of the field and heavy use on a sporting clays course.


